Program Descriptions: What's New This Month?

- History! When you see the word “History” or “Hist”, it means we are going to be learning about an important person, place or event in history through videos and discussion. In honor of Black History Month, we will be doing Histories on influential African Americans.

- Ice Cream Social Come grab an ice cream sundae and socialize with us!
- Happy Hour Grab some snacks and listen to some live entertainment!
- Monthly Auction Each resident receives \$10 in play money where you can “buy” items like toiletries, jewelry, snacks, decorations and more!
- Just Bead It! Just Bead It is a jewelry making class, led by an outside vendor where residents can make their own necklace and/or bracelet.
- Candle Light Dinner The Candle Light Dinner is held on the last Wednesday of the month. Residents at Resident Council make requests for a special menu that is then offered to everyone in the building. Those who dine in the Main Dining Room, will receive a more “restaurant” type service.
- Resident Council The Resident Council is a Resident-Run meeting where residents come together to discuss changes in the facility, monthly trips, meal options and suggestions for the kitchen and concerns. This meeting is confidential and only attended by Residents or those that Residents invite.

- October 11th Pumpkin Carving – Residents can choose the design of their choice and Activity Staff will carve the pumpkins to display in the courtyard! After we are finished carving, we will toast the pumpkin seeds!
- October 14th Pumpkin Biscuit Class – We are going to make Pumpkin Biscuits and Cinnamon Butter!
- October 17th Butternut Pasta Class – We are going to make delicious Butternut Squash Alfredo Pasta – a great Fall treat!
